

#### SECTION 5: FEE STRUCTURE

Fee:

CAAG assesses a fee of \$10,000 for the review of a proposed amendment to the 208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan (AWWQMP). This fee covers review of the document and the Public Participation Process as outlined in Chapter 8 of the AWWQMP, and CAAG's pamphlet, *Amending the CAAG 208 AWWQMP*, available for download at <a href="https://www.caagcentral.org/208/208home.html">www.caagcentral.org/208/208home.html</a>.

The fee is broken into two (2) installments:

- \$4,000 due upon the receipt of the Draft amendment. No work can be done on the plan until this installment is remitted.
- \$6,000 due prior to taking the plan through the Public Participation Process. This fee is usually due prior to the required Public Hearing.

The applicant may also elect to pay the entire fee in one installment. **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE**.

## What is included:

The fee covers the following:

- 1 pre-application meeting (2 pre-application meetings if applicant travels to CAAG).
- 1 meeting with local jurisdictions for the purposes of gaining political acceptance (Section 8.4.2(a)(1), *CAAG 208 AWWQMP amendment*, May 2005). Includes coordination by CAAG staff.
- Review of Draft 208 amendment in concert with ADEQ and other agencies as required or requested.
- 1 Public Hearing notice in a local newspaper.
- 1 Public Hearing, located near the proposed area, when possible and feasible
- 1 meeting with the CAAG Environmental Planning Committee
- 1 meeting with the CAAG Management Committee
- 1 meeting with the CAAG Region V Regional Council
- 1 meeting with the ADEO State Water Quality Management Working Group
- Submission of final amendment package to ADEQ and/or US EPA

## Additional fees:

Any item outside the above list of services is subject to an additional fee of \$90 per hour, billed monthly. Generally, these costs include extra meetings which require travel, preparation, coordination, additional public notices or public hearings, and/or additional Committee/Council meetings.

# Attorney fees:

Most amendments do not require legal advice. In the event CAAG must use its attorneys (Cooper & Rueter, LLP) or retain Special Counsel due to unusual circumstances, CAAG will bill for attorney's fees at the Attorney's current rate.

# Major revisions:

In the event the Regional Council deliberates over your amendment and either denies approval or requests major revisions that require the Draft to go through the Public Process again, your new amendment will be subject to a subsequent \$10,000 fee.
