TTAC RECOMMENDATION: That the Management Committee approve the recommendations of the Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) to make the Amendments to the CAG FY 2017 – FY 2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

DISCUSSION: CAG is responsible for programming the available Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) and Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) dollars for the CAG Region. The CAG FY 2017 — FY 2027 TIP programs the STP dollars for the next 10 years in alignment with the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The HSIP dollars are only being programmed out to FY 2018 as it will be the last year for apportionments before the dollars are open for a competitive bid process in FY 2019. The Amendments recommended by the TTAC are reflected in the attached TIP FY 2017 — FY 2027 document, and are outlined with a red box. The recommended changes to the CAG FY 2017 — FY 2027 TIP are as follows:

- 1. PAY 16-01C (TRACS # SZ06801C) E. Bonita Street (Phase IV) Reconstruction
 - a. Applying available FY 2017 STBGP dollars in the amount of \$172,905.36 to the project.
 - b. Increased STBGP dollars from \$485,012.75 to \$657,918.11.
 - c. Increased Local Match dollars from \$29,316.78 to \$39,768.11.
 - d. Total Project dollars from \$514,329.53 to \$697,686.22.
- 2. GLB 17-01C (TRACS # SZ15001C) Oak Street/Hill Street Pavement Rehabilitation & Sidewalks
 - a. Advancing project from FY 2018 to FY 2017
 - i. NACOG loaning \$643,000 of FY 2017 STBGP dollars to CAG, with payback due in FY 2018.
 - b. Applying available FY 2017 STBGP dollars in the amount of \$785 to the project.
 - c. Increased STBGP dollars from \$713,067.76 to \$713,852.76.
 - d. Increased Local Match dollars from \$43,101.66 to \$43,149.11.
 - e. Total Project dollars from \$756,169.42 to \$757,001.87.
