He informed the Council that the Management Committee voted that both items discussed were unfavorable. The Management Committee recommended designating a staff person to receive Parliamentary training for the Regional Council meetings and to provide Open Meeting Law training for the Regional Council. Questions, comments and discussion followed. Councilmember Waldron made a motion to accept the Management Committee's recommendation. Councilmember Carpenter seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

E. Review, Discussion and Decision on Amending CAG's Bylaws

Mr. Hall informed the Council that at the September 28, 2016 Regional Council meeting the Council

directed Staff to amend the CAG Bylaws changing the Election of Officers from September to November. Mr. Hall stated that the Management Committee voted to amend CAG's Bylaws changing the Election of Officers from September to the first meeting following November 15th of each year. He read an email provided by Chairman Benning. Questions, comments and discussion followed. STAFF RECOMMENDATION: For the Regional Council to recommend approval of the CAG Strategic Transportation Safety Plan (STSP).

DISCUSSION: A regional transportation safety plan utilizes the results of crash data analysis and stakeholder/public input to identify proven strategies, actions, programs, and projects to reduce the prevalence of transportation-related fatalities and serious injuries. Fatalities and serious injuries in the Region have fluctuated since 2005. Many of the incidents are considered predictable and preventable.

The purpose of the CAG STSP identifies the most important transportation safety issues in the CAG Region and offers strategies to comprehensively address these issues. The STSP provides CAG with a framework for reducing the personal and economic costs of crashes and enhances livability and public health in the Region. The STSP identifies emphasis areas, strategies and specific actions to cut transportation related fatalities and serious injuries by five percent annually as approved by the Multi-Disciplinary Safety Committee.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: Mr. Paul Jepson, City of Globe, made a motion to approve and pass to Regional Council CAG's Strategic Transportation Safety Plan (STSP). Ms. Jamie Bennett, Town of Queen Creek, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION: CAG is responsible for programming the available Surface Transportation Program (STP) and Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) dollars for the CAG Region. The CAG FY 2017 – FY 2027 TIP programs the STP dollars for the next 10 years in alignment with the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The HSIP dollars are only being programmed out to FY 2018 as it will be the last year for apportionments before the dollars are open for a statewide competitive bid process in FY 2019. The Amendments recommended by the TTAC are reflected in the attached TIP FY 2017 – FY 2027 document, and are outlined with a red box. The recommended changes to the CAG FY 2017 – FY 2027 TIP are as follows:

- 1. GIL 17-01D (TRACS # T008701D) Colcord Road Bridge Project (Design)
 - a. Applying ADOT Off-System Bridge Funds towards Design in FY 2017 in the amount of **\$204,000** and a Local Match of **\$12,331**.
 - b. Total funding for Design (includes FY 2017 STP funds and Local Match thereof) = **\$322,545**.
- 2. GIL 17-01C (TRACS # T008701C) Colcord Road Bridge Project (Construction)
 - a. Applying ADOT Off-System Bridge Funds towards Construction in FY 2020 in the amount of **\$796,000** and a Local Match of **\$48,114**.
 - b. Total funding for Construction (includes FY 2020 funds and Local Match thereof) = **\$1,234,114**.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff requests approval for the authorization to submit for 5310 grant funds through ADOT's application process to fund the Coordinated Mobility Management Program and duties thereof. On August 24, 2016, EPA received certification from the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) that the Central Arizona Governments (CAG) approved the update of their Clean Water Act (CWA) §208 Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP), that the update is consistent with Arizona's Continuing Planning Process (CPP), and the CAG WQMP. The letter explains that CAG is the Designated Planning Agency for Gila and Pinal Counties under CWA §208.

40 C.F.R. 130.6(e) provides that state and/or area wide agency WQMP's be updated as appropriate, that states ensure WQMP's include all necessary plan elements, that they are consistent with one another, that states certify updated WQMP's, and submit certification to EPA for approval.

EPA has reviewed ADEQ's certification that the WQMP addresses all the elements required by 40 CFR Part 130, including: TMDLs, effluent limitations, municipal and industrial waste treatment, nonpoint source management and control, management agencies, implementation measures, and ground water. EPA acknowledges that the WQMP update incorporates streamlining of the WQMP process, as well as, providing innovative strategies and tactics to achieve water quality protection and improvement. ADEQ's letter certifies that the WQMP update is consistent with Arizona's CPP and WQMP elements stated in 40 C.F.R. 130.6(c).
