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I. CALL TO ORDER

The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, Mr. Steve Sanders at 10:05 AM.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Sanders addressed the Committee, and asked whether there were any corrections or comments that needed to be made to the October 2, 2014 TTAC meeting minutes. Mr. Steve Sanders requested a motion to approve the September 11, and October 2, 2014 minutes. Mr. Jerry Barnes of the City of Globe made a motion and Ms. Sylvia Kerlock seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

VI. STANDING REPORTS

A. Member Jurisdictions - TTAC Members

Mr. Sanders requested that TTAC members provide Project Status reports.

- a) Mr. Steve Sanders from Gila County provided electronic and physical copies of the Gila County Projects Report.
- b) Mr. Curtis Ward from the Town of Payson reported that the half cent sales tax passed for maintenance and improvements. Street name signs have been received and the Town is upgrading roadway striping to a thermal-plastic material.
- c) Ms. Gaston from the Town of Superior reported that the Town turned back their HSIP money from fiscal year 2011 due to costs associated with project. The ADOT US 60 project is moving forward.
- d) Mr. Ashbaugh from Pinal County provided electronic and physical copies of Pinal County Projects.
- e) Mr. Curzon of the Town of Miami reported that there have been addendums to their HSIP project to correct incorrect street name signs.

B. ADOT Multi-Modal Planning Division - Charla Glendening

Ms. Glendening did not have an update to provide for the ADOT Multi-Modal Planning Division.

C. ADOT District Engineers – Globe & Tucson Districts

Ms. Dawson of the Tucson District reported that the SR 77 project at Aravaipa will be completed by March/April 2015, extending culverts on SR 79 and installing a round-a-bout at SR79/79B.

D. Transportation Planning Manager - Andy Smith

Mr. Smith informed the Committee about training on Road Safety Assessments sponsored by FHWA and ADOT. He also reported that he met with Cambridge Systematics about the refinement of tasks for the Transportation Safety Study. Mr. Smith also reported on presentations to the City of Apache Junction Council, the City of Coolidge Council and Gila County Board of Supervisors regarding the CAG Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

VII. OLD BUSINESS

A. Adoption of Regional Transportation Plan

Mr. Marum presented the CAG RTP and after some conversation, the item was tabled. The Consultant team and CAG Staff will provide revisions to Chapter 12 and redistribute the Chapter to the Committee for review.

Mr. Smith requested that TTAC members engage in a discussion with Mr. Breyer, Managing Member of Works Consulting, in an effort to accommodate the needs of their respective agencies regarding Highway Performance Monitoring Systems (HPMS).
